

Change Without Regulatory Effect

The California Board of Occupational Therapy (Board) seeks to eliminate all references relating to "certificate", "certified" or "certification" from Title 16, California Code of Regulations (CCR) Sections 4102, 4114, 4122, 4141, 4163, and 4181.

Effective January 1, 2010, SB 821 (Chapter 307, Statutes 2009) went into effect eliminating references to occupational therapy assistants as being "certified" and replaced that reference with being "licensed".

The proposed regulatory action is technical in nature and does not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription or other regulatory element of any California Code of Regulations provision. The proposed regulatory action will make the CCR consistent with reference and terminology used in statute.
