Discussion and action may be taken on any item listed on the agenda.

Discussing the issue of licensure, passing the exam administered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy and supervision of the capstone/clinical experience to include in a future report to the Board.
- 6. Review and discussion of the capstone/clinical experience completed as part of a doctoral program relative to the Occupational Therapy Practice Act requirements and possible recommendation(s) to the Board.
- 7. Identify the Committee's next steps to determine need for another meeting.
- 8. Suggested agenda items for a future meeting, if another meeting is necessary.
- 9. Select future meeting date(s) if another meeting is necessary.

Public comments will be taken on agenda items at the time the item is heard. **Discussion and action may be taken on any item listed on the agenda**.

Agenda items may be taken out of order for convenience, to accommodate speakers, or to maintain a quorum.

The Committee may discuss agenda items in any order on each day, unless noticed as "time certain." Agenda Items may be tabled or held over to a subsequent meeting and items noticed to be discussed may be moved up or taken out of order for convenience, to accommodate speakers, or to maintain a quorum.

In the event a quorum of the Committee is unable to attend the meeting, or the Committee is unable to maintain a quorum once the meeting is called to order, the Board president may, at his or her discretion, allow the remaining members to discuss items from the agenda and to make recommendations to the full board at a future meeting.

Opportunity for public comment is provided for each open agenda item.

The Committee Chairperson may, at her discretion, apportion available time among those who wish to provide comment.
