# Amend section 4147 of Division 39 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

## § 4147. Disciplinary Guidelines

- (a) In reaching a decision on a disciplinary action under the administrative adjudication provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code 11400 et seq.), the Board shall consider and apply the Disciplinary Guidelines [October 2013] [(OAL to insert month and year of adoption here)], which are hereby incorporated by reference. The Disciplinary Guidelines shall apply to all disciplinary matters. Deviation from these disciplinary guidelines and orders, including the standard terms of probation, is appropriate where the Board in its sole discretion determines that the facts of the particular case warrant such deviation, e.g., the presence of aggravating or mitigating factors; age of the case; or evidentiary issues.
- (b) All probationers shall submit and cause each health care employer to submit quarterly reports to the Board. The reports, "Quarterly Written Report (4/2011)"; and "Work Performance Evaluation (02/2011)"; shall be obtained from the Board and are hereby incorporated by reference.

### Amend subsection V (11) of the Disciplinary Guidelines

#### V. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

### **11.Cost Recovery Requirements**

Where an order for recovery of costs is made, respondent shall make timely payment as directed in the Board's Decision pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3. Respondent shall reimburse the Board for its investigation and prosecution costs. Respondent shall may be permitted to pay these costs in a payment plan approved by the Board. Respondent must submit a proposed payment plan within 30 days of the effective date of the decision and be approved by a Board representative. Payments shall be completed no later than six (6) months prior to the end of the probation term. Failure to make payments in accordance with any formal agreement entered into with the Board or pursuant to any Decision by the Board shall be considered a violation of probation. The Board shall not renew or reinstate the license of any rRespondent who has failed to pay all the costs as directed in a Decision.
